STOP Pressure Ulcers Day aims to raise awareness of the prevalence and importance of prevention of pressure ulcers (bedsores, decubitus ulcers) and to support evidence-based pressure ulcer prevention and treatment. Pressure ulcers are skin and tissue lesions that can occur at any age.

- According to the OECD 2022 report, pressure ulcers are a major adverse event in healthcare
- The costs of pressure ulcer treatment are estimated to be between 2% to 4% of the total healthcare expenditure
- Most of the pressure ulcers are preventable

By strategic leadership and coherent policies, we can strive to a shared understanding and commitment regarding the measures to be taken to effectively prevent pressure ulcer development. Let us achieve together the World Health Organization's patient safety action plan: "Towards Eliminating Avoidable Harm in Health Care".
